Parade Check In

Parade Check-in and staging will take place on River Road at Harrison Avenue.

Parade Route

Follow to Cottage Grove Library.

Staging begins at 8:00 pm. Parade will begin at 10 pm Sharp!

Parade Rules

1. For the safety of participants and spectators candy or favors may not be thrown from any moving vehicle. Candy or favors *may be handed* out to the parade spectators by walkers.
2. No exhibition of speed by motorized vehicles. All go-carts or similar racing vehicles shall be on trailers.
3. Entries must be less than 14 feet high.
4. Shine your Lights!
