## BMD Vendor 2021 Application & Contract

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 62<sup>nd</sup> Bohemia Mining Days Celebration!

**BMD 2021 will be different this year!** Due to financial challenges resulting from the COVID-19 cancellation of BMD 2020, we are unable to create “Bohemia City” for three days in Coiner Park this year. Instead, we are producing a scaled-back two-day event, on Saturday, July 17 and Sunday, July 18, in the Historic Downtown District that introduces a new competition in the Slabtown vs. Lemati Feud: **Mine Ore Cart Races**.

**Attractions:** In addition to the races, there will be live music in All America City Square (Opal Park), a Kid Zone on Washington Avenue between 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Streets and two parades. Vendors will set up on side streets (6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>) to keep Main Street open for access to the downtown businesses. COVID-19 created financial hardships for these business owners and BMD organizers want to bring many people to the historic district for two days and create a much-needed economic boost for them. We have eight eateries and five “watering holes” in the District; therefore, we will not have a food court or beer/wine garden this year and we encourage attendees to support them. We are accepting applications for “fair food” vendors such as shaved ice, elephant ears, ice cream, popcorn, cotton candy, etc.

**Vendor Spaces:** We have **70 booth spaces for this event**. First preference will be given to our long-time vendors.

**First time BMD Vendors:** Before applying, call our Vendor Coordinator Linda Sexton to inquire about booth availability.

**Venue Hours: Saturday, Noon-9 pm and Sunday, Noon-6 pm.** Main Street will be closed to traffic on Saturday between 5:30-9:30 pm and on Sunday between 1:30-6:30 pm. Security is provided from 9:30 pm-9:30 am.

**Vendor Set Up:** Saturday from 9 am-Noon

**Vendor Fees:** We have *greatly* discounted our rates this year because of the shorter event and because we are unable to offer electricity or water to our vendor booths in this location.

**COVID-19 Safety Protocols:** We will follow our City-approved COVID-19 Safety Guidelines to ensure the health and safety of our attendees.
