Entry Fees

\$25 Commercial (Business, Individual group of 3 or more)

\$25 Political (any political float or individual)

\$25 Individuals (Any private individual, 3 or more)

\$10 Non-profit (Festival Courts, Clubs, Churches & Individuals)

\$10 Individuals (Any private individual i.e. horse & rider, person(s) in a car)

Where: All parade participants will check-in on 10th Street between Polk & Taylor Avenues. At check-in entrants will be given their parade number. Staging will be on South 10th Street between Taylor and Jackson Avenues. The parade route will begin on South 10th Street at Quincy Avenue and head north to Main Street. The parade will turn right and proceed east on Main Street to Gateway Boulevard. The parade will then turn right at Gateway with the parade ending at the intersection of Gateway and 16th Street. Parade participants will then disburse on Gateway. The parade is about 0.8 miles long. **Staging will begin at 8 a.m. on South 10th St. All entries must be in place, ready for the parade, by 9 a.m.**

Judging: During the parade, judging will take place at the Judges Booth located in front of the Coiner Park tennis courts on Main Street. Your representative can stop by Bohemia City Hall (festival info booth across from the gazebo) after 2 p.m. to see if your entry won a ribbon. Otherwise the ribbons will be mailed to you.

Rules: Entrants must agree to abide by our anti-discrimination and anti-harassment policy and support Festival guidelines. BMD has the right to deny any entrant and/or participant from the parade. The final decision rests with the Festival Coordinator (or Assistant Festival Coordinator in his/her absence).

1. For the safety of participants and spectators, candy or favors may not be thrown from any moving vehicle. Candy or favors may be handed out to parade spectators by walkers.
2. No exhibition of speed by motorized vehicles. All go-carts or similar racing vehicles shall be on trailers.
3. All entries must be less than 14 feet high.
4. No water shall be squirted from float into spectators.
5. Smile and have fun.
